## Listening in Mission



Following feedback from previous participants, Knox Centre for Ministry and Leadership invites ministry practitioners to Listening in Mission. Listening is an active process, in which we grow by doing. It begins with action, stepping into the space of another. It proceeds by “double listening” - to God and people. Online technologies will support leaders in undertaking a practical project in their community. As a result, a spirituality of presence, community building, attentiveness, discernment, experimentation is encouraged. Listening in Mission sets up the next KCML lifelong learning offering - Experimenting in Mission.

Participants commit to 5 **online sessions** with ministry colleagues and KCML team. Together we will listen to Scripture, clarify expectations, integrate pre-reading, share advice in difficulties and celebrate progress. This builds collegiality in mission. A free taster (Aug 29) is a no commitment introduction to the process + project.

Participants commit to a **practical local project**, gathering a team to engage in provided local listening exercises. This ensures practical, local learning.
